

We warmly invite submission of abstracts on the theme of health, to join our panel at the upcoming UACES conference in Lisbon. The panel will explore all areas of EU health governance, including but not limited to (indicative list only):

- The role of European actors – the Commission, the Parliament, the agencies, etc. – in health and health governance
- Governing health emergencies and managing collective health threats in Europe
- Public health, health determinants and health inequalities in and across member states
- The impact of the single market upon health systems, for example via competition law, migration of health professionals, trade...
- The inclusion of health in broader governance frameworks such as the European Semester, the Pillar of Social Rights, Europe 2020...
- The World Health Organization 'One Health' strategy and its promotion and implementation in the EU.

We welcome papers from all disciplines (law, public policy, economics, public health, global health etc.). If you are planning to submit a paper on a topic related to the above, and are interested in doing so as part of a pre-formed panel, please send your abstract to Eleanor Brooks (University of Edinburgh) and Thibaud Deruelle (University of Exeter) by Friday 14 December. We will select from these a panel of papers and confirm inclusion before the Christmas break, so that any unsuccessful submissions can be sent to the general call ahead of the 20 January deadline.
