The State of the European Union A Report



As part of UACES' work to help colleagues reach a wider audience, we published a report on "The State of the European Union" in June, in collaboration with UK in a Changing Europe. The report brings together 24 short, accessible chapters on the EU's institutions, key member states, policies and external reports, reflecting on the impact of both the Covid pandemic and the Russian invasion of Ukraine. It highlights the interconnected nature of the challenges that face the EU at present and the potential for both further consolidation of the bloc and its undermining. The report is targeted at key stakeholders in governments, business and media and showcases the excellent research being done by colleagues in a format that aims to stimulate further interactions. UK in a Changing Europe, funded by the Economic and

Social Research Council, is interested in promoting a wide range of research, across disciplines, on the UK and the EU, so if you have work that you think might be of interest to them, then drop them a note through their website.

The journal is now open and accepting papers for publication.


